Neighborhood Care **Watch Red flags such as:**

- Not sure if they are getting proper nutrition
- Unsafe at home alone due to balance
- Confusion, agitation or paranoia (sometimes all)
- Loneliness (#1 missed factor when assessing seniors)
- Increasing dependency on you for transportation or help
- Isolation or confinement
- Lack of hygiene, house not being cleaned, incontinence or wearing the same clothes.
- Being taken advantage of by business or family (Senior Fraud)
- Notice significant health changes in the caregiver (the healthy one)
